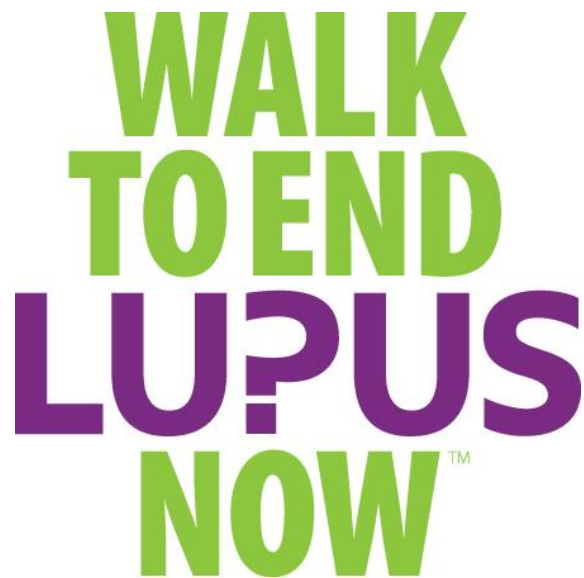

The purpose of the Walk Mentor Committee is to involve local volunteers, *you*, in the development of fundraising tools and the communication with, cultivation of, and encouragement of our fundraisers and teams.

The Walk Mentor Committee is part of the evolution of our previously called “Ambassador Committee”. The Ambassador Committee grew in strength over the years and now is the perfect time to hone in on the progress we’ve made, the talents we’ve recruited, and the fresh ideas we’ve come up with. **The Walk Mentor Committee will now solely focus on the areas in which directly affect our fundraisers and walk teams and their experience.**

### **Areas of Duty**

Mentors will assist in the cultivation and motivation of walkers and teams during the months prior to the walk. Acting as both a role model and a leader, mentors will offer a personal touch to our participants! Mentors will also have the opportunity to help the LFANC staff develop new fundraising guides to equip our fundraisers with the tools needed to succeed.

### **Responsibilities**

#### **➤ Time Commitment:**

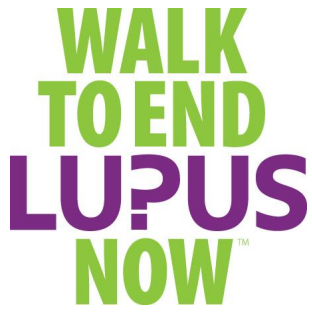
- Attend all meetings/calls - approx. 1 per month in the months prior to the event (**Allowed to miss no more than 1 meeting/call**)
- Devoting time on specified assignments (approx. 3-6 hours a month)
- Making yourself available for check-in calls with LFANC staff
- Attend participant fundraising events as a LFANC representative as needed

#### **➤ Expectations:**

- LFANC will provide topics for you to communicate to teams each month
  - Make monthly phone calls providing motivation and ideas
  - Send bi-weekly/monthly emails providing walk resources and tips
- Assist in research and development of fundraising tools with the guidance of the LFANC staff
- Delivering progress reports to the Mentor Committee at each meeting/call
- Attend participant fundraising events as a LFANC representative as needed
- Attending and assisting with prior-to, day-of, and post-event activities for the walk, such as Kickoff Party, Victory Party – Great way to meet your assigned teams in person!

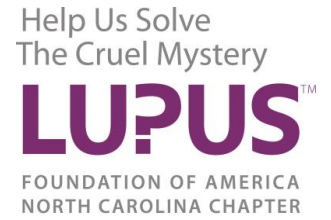
